

Middle School Criteria for Choosing AR books

1. Books can be any AR grade level as long as they are listed on the 6-8 Grade Sunshine State Young Readers Award list (SSYRA label is on spine of the book in library or you could check their website for the list of winners at <http://www.floridamediaed.org/ssyra-6-8-resources.html>).
2. Books that are in our school library with a green sticker on the spine
3. The book's interest level is MG+ or UG (the MG must have a '+' (plus) behind it to automatically be approved, not just the MG)
4. The book level is 6.0 or higher
5. The book level is 4th or 5th grade AND is worth 11 points or more

All the books the students quiz on must meet the above criteria. Each quarter they must take a quiz on at least one book that is on their grade level or above (example: 7th grader must take a quiz on a book level of 7th or 8th grade). If the interest level is UG, that automatically counts as an "on level" book.

www.ARbookfind.com gives this information about the books. When in doubt, check this website before taking the time to read the book.
