Dear Parent/Guardian,

It is the policy of TCS that students who take vacations, extended days off, or non-emergency absences during school hours do so with the full understanding that they are responsible for the course work covered during their absence. Since a part of a student's evaluation may include daily contributions and activities, absence from school has a direct effect upon these areas. Due to the nature of some course work, it may not be possible to "make-up" all material covered. We are concerned that the above mentioned circumstances during class time will affect your child's progress. Pre-planned vacations, etc. must have prior approval from the principal.

Work that is given to a student is expected to be completed upon the student's return to school (unless otherwise pre-arranged with the teacher). Any additional work that was assigned during the absence period will need to be completed according to the policies in the TCS Parent/Student Handbook.
